N. Main Street Sewer Main Replacement

The Village of Fairport will be replacing a portion of the storm sewer located on N. Main Street directly north of Railroad Street due to a failure in the infrastructure. The work is anticipated to commence on or about Wednesday, November 2, 2016. The project's duration will take approximately 3-5 business days to complete depending on the extent of the infrastructure repair. Southbound thru traffic between High Street and the CSX Railroad Crossing will be prohibited during the construction phase. The Village will make every attempt to allow vehicles to travel to businesses in the southbound lane up to the work zone, however we respectfully request patrons utilize the north bound lane to access businesses within this area as this lane should be open for the majority of the project, unless the work requires intermittent access of the northbound lane.

Vehicular traffic in or around the area is recommended to utilize the designated detour route which will be High Street traveling east to Turk Hill Road, Turk Hill Road traveling southbound to East Church Street and East Church Street traveling west to S. Main Street. All businesses and merchants will have access to their establishments and be open for business during this time.
