

POSITION: Full and Alternate Members of the Historic Preservation Commission

LENGTH OF TERM: 5 years

RESPONSIBLE TO: The Historic Preservation Commission is responsible for maintaining the historic integrity of the Village of Fairport. In particular, the powers of the Commission are:

1. Designation of identified structures or resources as landmarks and historic districts.
2. Increasing public awareness of the value of historic, cultural and architectural preservation.
3. Approval or disapproval of applications for certificates of appropriateness.

TIME COMMITMENT: Approximately 5 hours per month

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

The Historic Preservation Commission consists of five (5) citizens appointed by the Board of Trustees to serve a five (5) year term. The Mayor, with approval of the Board of Trustees appoints a chair and the Commission annually elects a vice-chair from their membership.

ALTERNATE MEMBERSHIP

Two alternate members may be appointed by the Board of Trustees to substitute for a regular member of the HPC in the event that a regular member is unable to participate in matters before the HPC because of a conflict of interest, illness or other absence.
