NIGHTTIME PAVING WORK TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK ALONG EAST CHURCH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF FAIRPORT

The New York State Department of Transportation today announced that milling and paving work will begin next Monday night to repair and resurface East Church Street between Route 250 (Main Street) and Turk Hill Road in the Village of Fairport, Monroe County.

Beginning Monday, June 17, milling and paving will take place during the overnight hours from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. An alternating single-lane traffic pattern will be required for up to two weeks, weather depending.

This work is being performed as part of the Liftbridge Rehabilitation Project in anticipation of higher traffic volumes along East Church Street once the Route 250 Liftbridge closes for repairs in September.

Motorists are urged to slow down and safely move over when approaching roadside vehicles displaying red, white, blue, amber or green lights, including maintenance and construction vehicles in work zones.
